Time had weathered one of downtown St. Louis' most historic buildings, and a new name was about to make big changes. In 1993, the Lawrence Group, which provides architectural, interior design and town planning services worldwide, bought the 111-year-old Security Building. The Group selected this site, which has great views of Eero Saarinen's Gateway Arch, as its headquarters. Upon completing a renovation in 2007, the Security Building received LEED® Silver certification.
